CLUB ORGANISATIONAL STRUCTURE

TWLA is primarily by volunteers, with some nominally paid teenage helpers. To have a successful season for our athletes, we need everyone to do their part.

Parents/Caregivers

- Staff the BBQ/canteen on a rostered basis by age group (age group activities will be suspended if the required number of volunteers do not report for duty).
- Pack away field equipment when their age group is the last to compete.
- Unless assisting as above, remain with their child's age group to supervise their children* and assist the Age Manager with non-rostered duties (e.g., place-judging, hurdles changes, marking, etc.).

Teenage Helpers

- The club employs a limited number of teenage helpers with past Little Athletics experience to assist with set up, starting, timekeeping and other general needs to facilitate an efficient and consistent competition night.
- The helpers operate under the direction of the Committee only no parent/caregiver or Age Manager may ask the teenage helper to perform any duty on the night.

Age Manager

- Shows up every week or organises a replacement from their Age Group.
- Ensures athletes complete the stated program in the correct order, properly execute the events within the stated specifications and have their results recorded accurately.
- Maintains order amongst the athletes (with parent assistance).

Officials (performed by the Age Manager if not specifically allocated)

Ensures proper execution of events – both in terms of schedule and skills.

Committee

- Responsible for governance and organisation of Club activities.
- * Per the LANSW constitution and insurance structure, Little Athletics is <u>NOT</u> a drop and go activity.
